

Privacy Notice *Future Forum Europe 2019*

1. Introduction

This Privacy Notice is intended to describe the practices related to the registration for the participation in the *Future Forum Europe 2019 ("Event")* with respect to the privacy of all individuals whose personal data is processed and stored in the registration tool.

2. Who will host the event

"EY" refers to one or more of the member firms of Ernst & Young Global Limited ("EYG"), each of which is a separate legal entity and can act as a data controller in its own right. The entity that is acting as data controller by hosting the Event is the Ernst & Young GmbH Wirtschaftsprüfungsgesellschaft in cooperation with the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Auswärtige Politik eV ("DGAP").

EY hired MCI Deutschland GmbH ("MCI") for the development and maintenance of this registration tool and to organize the registration for the Event taking place on January 15th, 2019 in Berlin on behalf of EY as processor. EY, DGAP and MCI are committed to safeguarding the privacy of all participants registering through this software. The purpose of this privacy notice is to outline what data we might collect.

The registration system is owned by MCI and hosted on servers that are located in Geneva, Switzerland.

3. Why do we need your information?

The purpose of the registration tool is to process your registration information for the smooth handling of the registration process.

EY relies on your consent as basis to legitimize the processing of your personal data in MCI's registration tool:

The provision of your personal data is optional, however, please be aware that if you do not provide us with all or part of your personal data, we may not be able to carry out the smooth registration process.

4. What type of personal data is processed in the Tool?

The Tool processes the following categories of personal data:

last name, first name, job title, company and email address.

This data is being collected in order to (1) manage your registration and keep you updated on all matters that concern your registration, (2) provide the services to you that you have requested, (3) to contact you when necessary or appropriate in relation to the event.

5. Sensitive Personal Data

Sensitive personal data is data revealing your racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data, data concerning health or data concerning sex life or sexual orientation.

MCI Deutschland GmbH does not collect any sensitive personal data from you via the registration tool, and it is not the intention of the tool to process such information.

6. Who can access your information?

Your personal data may be accessed in the registration tool by the following persons/teams:

MCI:

Authorized Employees of MCI Deutschland GmbH, all located in Germany, have access to your personal information to conduct the registration process.

EY & DGAP:

Authorized employees of EY and DGAP involved in the Organisation committee of the Event may access your personal data in order to facilitate the organisation of the Event. All respective Individuals of EY and DGAP are located in Germany.

Service Provider:

Further, authorized Service Providers used by MCI in order to facilitate the registration process may access your personal data. These respective Service providers are:

7. Data retention

Your personal data will be retained by MCI in order to successfully complete the registration process for the event and to provide you with all information related to this event. Your personal data will not be stored for more than two month after the Event (i.e. till March 2019)

Your personal data will be retained in compliance with privacy laws and regulations.

After the end of the data retention period, your personal data will be deleted.

8. Security

MCI is committed to making sure that your personal data is kept secure. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, MCI has put in place appropriate technical and organizational measures to safeguard and secure your personal data. All MCI personnel and the third parties which are engaged to process your personal data are obliged to respect the confidentiality of your data.

9. Controlling your personal data

EY and MCI won't transfer your personal data to third parties (other than any external parties referred to in section 6 above) unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

You are legally entitled to request details of the personal data which we hold about you.

10. Rectification, erasure or restriction of processing

You can confirm your personal data is accurate and current. You can request rectification, erasure, restriction of processing or a readily portable copy of your personal data by contacting your usual EY representative or by sending an e-mail to info@future-forum-europe.com. We will use reasonable efforts to contact you regarding your request.

11. Complaints

If you are not satisfied with the way in which MCI Deutschland GmbH resolved your complaint, you have the right to complain to the data protection authority. You may also refer the matter to a court of competent jurisdiction.
